



## Why, a guide?

Your teacher recently assigned a project that requires you to question, think, and present your understandings. Combine the processes of **questioning**, **thinking**, and **presenting**, and you create real life! Read on ....

**Questioning:** You ask many questions every day of yourself and to others. Which college provides the best program for me? How will I present this information to my manager? What food should I make for dinner? Which new car meets my personal and financial needs? How will I find a job that will help pay for my car insurance?

**Thinking:** You may need to find information, call a friend or business with questions, think through the possibilities, take notes, gather more information, decide if the information that you found presents a bias, and formulate opinions or points of view of your own. Your sources might include interviews, books, databases, web sites, newspapers and other sources of current news, and people.

**Presenting:** The presentation may take the form of a written thesis paper, a multimedia or web-based presentation, a verbal debate, or another form of communication.
