Definition of Mental Health

- Developmental & emotional milestones
- Social skills
- Coping skills
- Positive quality of life
- Home, school, community functioning

Mental Health Disorders . Si

- Significant changes to learning, behavior, emotional regulation
- Persistent fears and worries
- Challenging behaviors
- ADHD, Anxiety, Behavioral Disorders



22% of youth ages 13-18 experience a mental disorder

Prevalence Rates

- Anxiety 9.4%
- Depression 4.4%

Suicide is the second leading cause of death for children ages 10-19



Health Curriculum

- MS curriculum: stress management, self-care, mental health challenges, expressing emotions
- HS curriculum: emotional intelligence, factors impacting stress, empathy & resilience, suicide risk & prevention, mental health illness and treatment



Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS)

Individual counseling, Behavior Intervention Plan (BIP), Special Education

Mentoring Backpack program, Power of Peace, Kids Hope, Sisters, Zones of Regulation, Counseling, Behavior Support Plan

Tier 1 (80%) School-wide Programs, Curriculum, Interventions Character Education, WEB, Responsive Classroom, Restorative Practices


