RESOLUTION FOR EMERGENCY APPLICATION OF AN
APPROPRIATE PESTICIDE
JUNE 10, 2024

BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Education of the Scotia-Glenville Central School District (“District”) hereby determines that the condition of the District’s High School field hockey field poses an imminent threat to the health and safety of the students using that athletic field and surrounding grounds for athletic events and other school purposes, and renders that athletic field and surrounding grounds unusable until the imminent threat to the health and safety of the students is eliminated;

The condition of the District’s High School field hockey field poses an imminent threat to the health and safety of the students who use that athletic field and surrounding grounds, and constitutes an emergency as contemplated by Education Law Section 409-k;

The Buildings and Grounds Supervisor for the District is hereby authorized to coordinate the emergency application of an appropriate pesticide or pesticides as defined by Environmental Conservation Law Section 33-0101, to the extent necessary to abate the current unusable condition of the athletic field and surrounding grounds and return them to a safe condition for use by students;

The Buildings and Grounds Supervisor, as School Pesticide Representative, working with its contractor, Greener World Landscape Maintenance, L.L.C., is hereby directed to provide such notification of the emergency application of pesticide undertaken pursuant to this authorization as is required by 8 NYCRR Section 155.24 and Education Law Section 409-h;

This resolution shall take effect immediately and shall be in effect for a period of one year.
