- Planning and Preparation Mrs. Paratore utilizes testing data and classroom teacher input when developing individual and group intervention plans for student/groups. Lessons are well organized, and students are familiar and comfortable with the routine and structure of the lesson.
- Classroom Environment Mrs. Paratore's students have a clear understanding of the learning expectations, as well as their individual reading goals. Students are observed tracking and celebrating their progress each day and appear motivated to do so. The classroom environment is very conducive to learning. Students enjoy learning and are very eager to participate in the discussions with Mrs. Paratore. The interactions between Mrs. Paratore and her students demonstrate mutual respect. Mrs. Paratore challenges her students to meet their goals, however students know it is okay for them to make mistakes. Students are comfortable growing as readers in her class.  to no down time.
- Professional Responsibilities Mrs. Paratore has been a wonderful addition to the Lincoln staff. She is well respected by her colleagues and is highly effective at contributing during team meetings in a professional manner.
