Re: CDPHP Pharmacy Changes

CDPHP has provided the district with an updated list of preferred pharmacy locations for prescriptions. As of July 1, 2025, the most notable change is that CVS will no longer be a preferred pharmacy. Enrollees affected by this change will receive a letter from CDPHP.

The following will continue to be preferred pharmacy locations:

ConnectRx Optum Home Delivery

Food Lion Rite Aid
Giant Foods ShopRite
Hannaford Stop & Shop
Kinney Drugs Walgreens
Market 32/Price Chopper Walmart

Multiple independent pharmacies

If you use a non-preferred pharmacy not on the list, be assured that they are still *in the network* and it will cost 50% of the cost of the prescription drug.
