




1 labeled lunch box/bag (if you plan on bringing lunch from home)

1 labeled kid-sized reusable water bottle (this goes home daily: no juice, Gatorade, Powerade, milk-used for water only)




1 labeled plastic

(no characters, zippers, or locks)




2 boxes of 24 count crayons




2 boxes of tissues
