












# Lincoln Kindergarten Supply List

<p>1 large backpack, no wheels (large enough to fit clothes, projects, lunch and snack bags)</p>		<p>1 labeled lunch box/bag (if you plan on bringing lunch from home)</p>	
<p>1 labeled snack pouch (smaller and separate from the lunch box/bag)</p>		<p>1 full set of clothes in a large labeled Ziploc bag</p>	
<p>1 labeled old large pull over t-shirt (for an art smock)</p>		<p>2 boxes of plain tissues (no aloe or Vicks)</p>	
<p>1 labeled kid-sized reusable water bottle (this goes home daily: no juice, Gatorade, Powerade, milk- used for water only)</p>		<p>1 labeled plastic supply tub/hard top pencil box (no characters, zippers, or locks)</p>	
<p>2 boxes of 24 count crayons</p>		<p>Elmer's purple washable disappearing glue sticks (you pick any amount from 1-8, no name needed)</p>	
<p>1 container of baby wipes</p>		<p>*When looking for clothes, shoes, and supplies- remember <u>simple</u> is best for school mode. Try to avoid things with lights, pop-its, flaps, sequins, anything that can be of an extra distraction etc...</p>










# 2nd Grade Supply List




As we head into Fall 2024 - Regular pencils and glue sticks will be collected and given out as needed. All extra supplies will be kept in a labeled bag.

*\*A Lincoln School folder & assignment notebook will be supplied for each child.\**

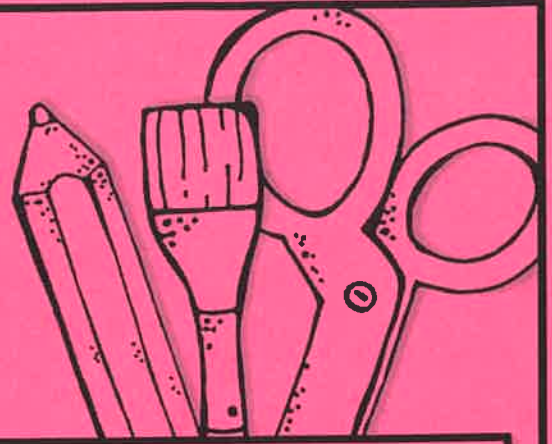

We hope you enjoy your summer and look forward to seeing you in the fall. The following is a list of the items you will need for fifth grade:

- backpack

- 3 pocket folders (Label: Math, Science, Social Studies)
- 1 three ring binder- 1.5"
- Big Tab Dividers (for binder) 8 count
- paper (wide-ruled loose leaf)
