

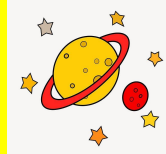

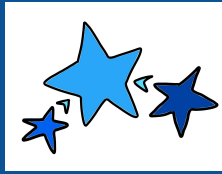

The grade-level goals on the F&P Text Level Gradient™ are intended to provide general guidelines, which should be adjusted based on school/district requirements and professional teacher judgement.

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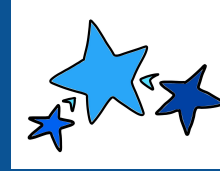
# ASSESSMENT

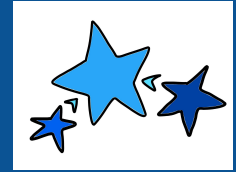
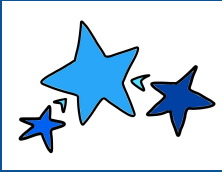


# LEARNING LEAPS 2023 - FOLLOW UP REPORT



Available Fall 2023 data was collected and compared to Spring 2023 F&P levels. The sample size was 58 students. Current 6th grade students were not included in the data comparison as they do not conduct F&P testing at the middle school (iReady is used in place of F&P testing). It was found that 74% of students surveyed maintained, or increased, their Spring F&P level during Fall F&P testing. 26% of students surveyed tested below their Spring F&P during Fall F&P testing. Attendance data was also included in the collection.

Updated data will be available for Learning Leaps 2024 after October 4th.



- Data will be collected through Fall 2024 F&P testing after October 4th, 2024.
- This was our last Learning Leaps year sponsored by grant funds.





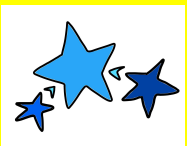
