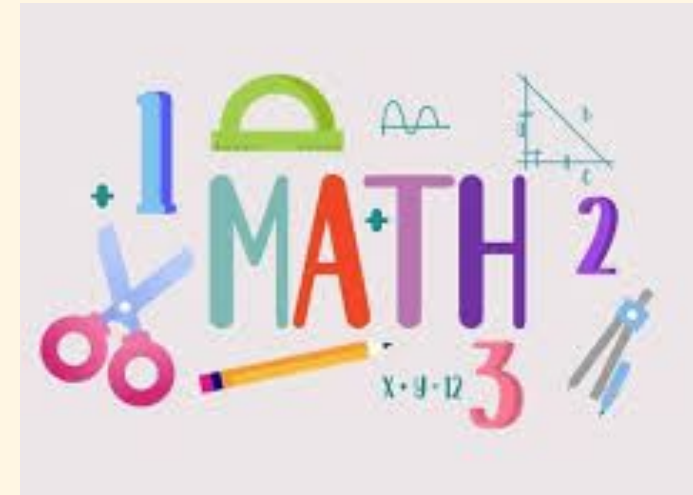

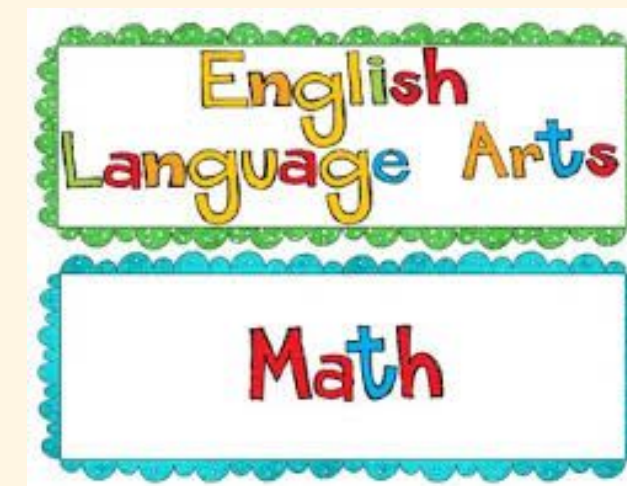

High School

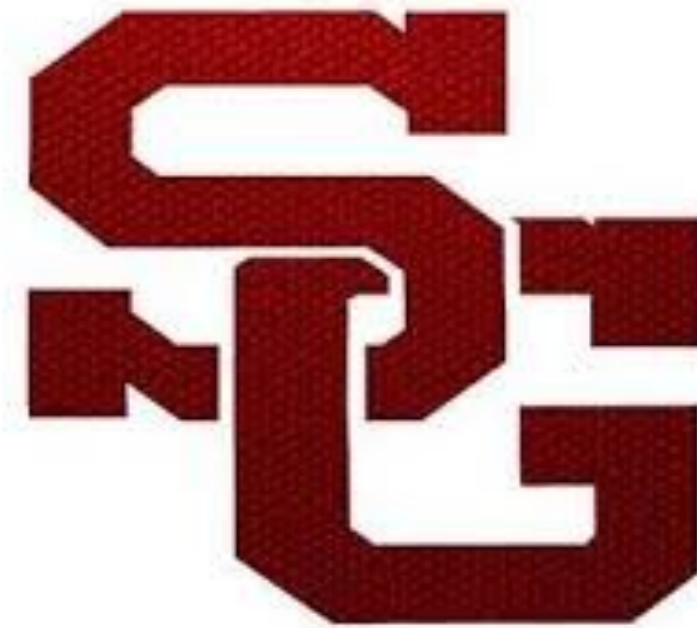
- **85% attendance during the school year**
