

RESOLUTION

NOTICE OF INTENT TO SERVE AS LEAD AGENCY UNDER THE STATE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REVIEW ACT AND ITS IMPLEMENTING REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, the Scotia-Glenville Central School District Board of Education of the “Board” is considering, as part of a Capital Improvement Project, providing improvements to their transportation facility located at 500 Sacandaga Road Glenville NY 12302. Improvements include removal of the existing Beukendaal Building, replacement of existing parking lot, fencing, installation of new EV bus power stations and associated infrastructure, and new overflow parking lot, as set forth on Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the Project requires that an environmental review be conducted in compliance with Article 8 of the New York State Environmental Conservation Law and its implementing regulations at 6 NYCRR Part 617 (the “Regulations”), collectively the State Environment Quality Review Act (“SEQRA”); and

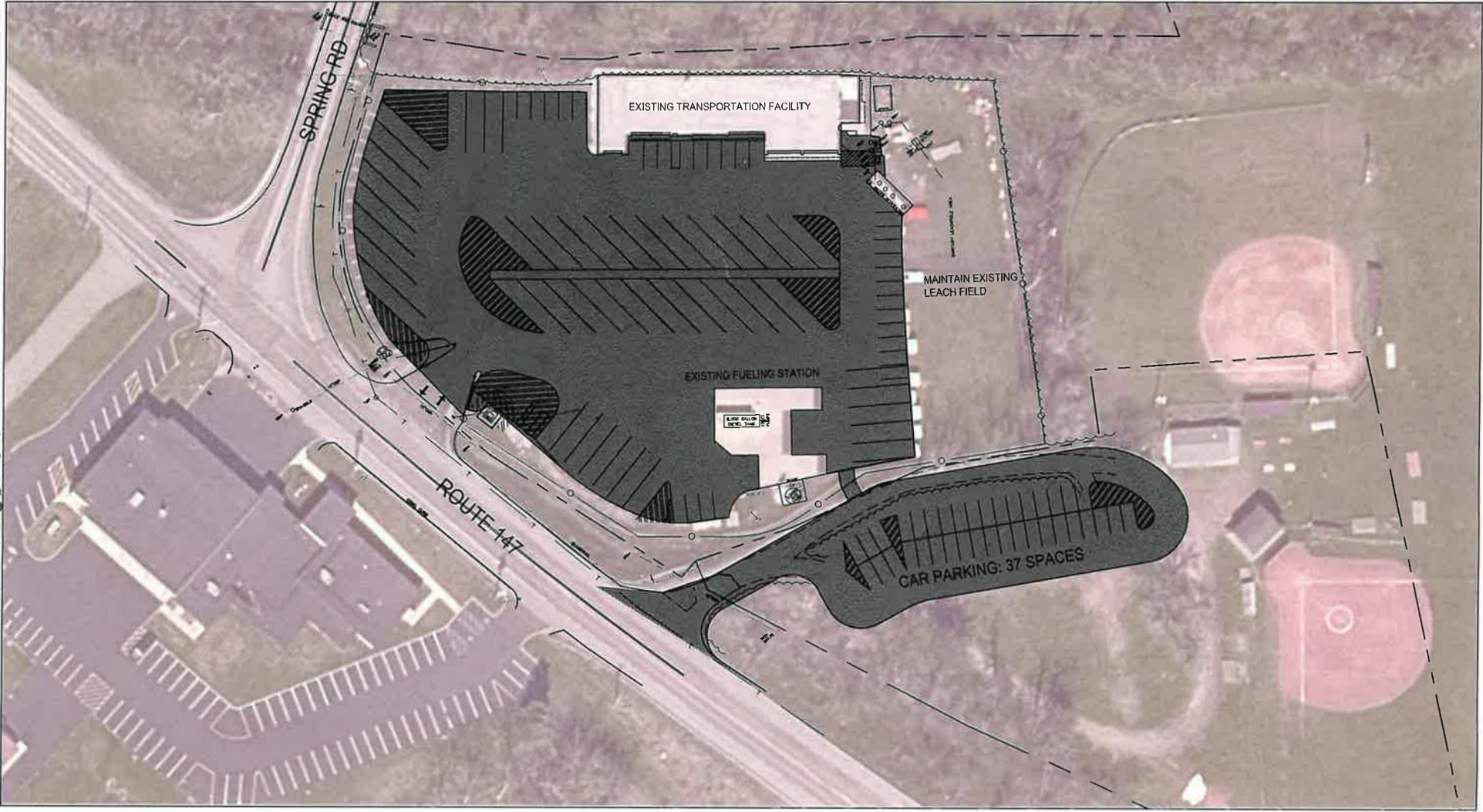
WHEREAS, the Board believes that it should be designated as Lead Agency for the purpose of determining the environmental impact of the Project and intends to declare itself as Lead Agency and conduct a coordinated SEQRA review of the Project; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board:

1. Hereby establishes their intent to be the Lead Agency for purposes of determining the environmental impact of the Project; and
2. This Resolution will take effect immediately.

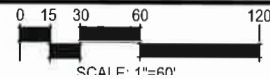


Scotia Glenville Transportation Facility Parking
