Agenda Items

Senate Bill 3397A-Maximum Temperature in School (Jon Van Alstyne)

• Senate Bill 3397A-Maximum Temperature in School was signed into law and will take effect on September 1, 2025. The law requires schools to act if temperatures in learning spaces reach 82 degrees Fahrenheit. Actions to reduce the temperature can include turning off lights, opening windows, using fans, turning off unused electronics, and allowing for water breaks. The learning space can no longer be occupied if the temperature reaches 88 degrees Fahrenheit. It was mentioned that school administrators should begin identifying spaces now in their buildings that will likely be impacted by high temperatures. Once these areas are identified, an action plan should be established. The Board of Education will also need to establish a policy. Building leaders will also need to establish a functional annex in their Building-level Emergency Response Plans. Mr. Zwack has begun to develop a list of air-conditioned areas in each building. Further discussion was had regarding certain individual buildings.

Senate Bill S7424- Requires Youth and Sports Camps to Establish an AED Implementation Plan (Jon Van Alstyne)

• Mr. Giaquinto stated that the school district has completed the necessary steps and outside sporting groups with 5 or more teams are responsible for submitting this information through ML Schedules.

Round Table

• School Resource Officer Ecker inquired about the Building-level Emergency Response Plan and the new principal at Glen Worden Elementary. A short discussion was had.

Capital Project Update (Drew Giaquinto)

• Mr. Giaquinto stated that the construction bids for the \$12.5 million dollar capital project should be out soon and will be rewarded in the spring. The Middle School, Lincoln, Glen Worden, and Glendaal will have their vestibules retrofitted this summer to enhance safety and security. The High School and Sacandaga will have their vestibules retrofitted during the following summer. The school district is also working on a new Raptor policy to go with the security enhancements. A short discussion regarding the vestibule design and Raptor was had. Mr. Giaquinto also mentioned that carpeting and railings in the Middle School auditorium are set to be replaced through the project.
