Standard Response Protocol – I Love U Guys Foundation (Jon Van Alstyne)

- The Standard Response Protocol from the I Love U Guys Foundation goes into effect July 1, 2025, by order of NYSED. Members of the Health and Safety Committee were provided with copies of new forms and terminology. A major change from previous guidance involves the term “lockout.” The new Standard Response Protocol uses the term “secure” or “secure lockout.” A discussion was had. Staff will be provided with the new guidance before July 1 and training on this topic will likely occur during a professional development day next school year.

General Safety Reminders (Jon Van Alstyne)

- Please ensure that ice and snow are cleared from all school building exit doors. State Education has received general complaints regarding this as it violates the fire code. Means of egress cannot be blocked. On another note, the use of salt to melt ice in and around doorways can lodge underneath the door and inadvertently prop the door open. Please ensure that salt is cleared from entrances.
