**ANNUAL SCHOOL DISTRICT MEETING AND ELECTION, BUDGET VOTE AND PUBLIC HEARING FOR DISCUSSION OF EXPENDITURES OF FUNDS AND BUDGETING THEREOF**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Annual School Election and voting upon the 2025-2026 annual School Budget will be held for the qualified voters of the Scotia-Glenville Central School District in the gymnasium of the Scotia-Glenville High School, 1 Tartan Way, in said school district on Tuesday, May 20, 2025.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that balloting by means of voting machines upon the authorization of the necessary taxes to meet the estimated expenditures as set forth in the proposed budget, the election of members of the Board of Education and any proposition brought before the voters of the district, will take place between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that the Board of Education shall hold a public hearing for the purpose of discussion of the expenditure of funds and the budgeting thereof in the cafeteria of the Scotia-Glenville Middle School, 10 Prestige Parkway, in said school district, Wednesday, May 7, 2025 at 7:00 p.m.

Propositions to amend the budget, or other propositions to be presented to the voters at the election on May 20, 2025, must be submitted to the Clerk of the Board of Education no later than 5:00 p.m., Monday, April 21, 2025. Any such proposition must clearly state the proposition and carry the name and address of at least 56 qualified voters of the district. The Board of Education has the right to determine the propriety of any proposition.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that a copy of the statement of the amount of money which will be required for the ensuing year for school purposes may be obtained by any taxpayer in the district during the seven days immediately preceding the scheduled public hearing on May 7, 2025, except Saturday, Sunday or holiday, at any of the schools currently operated by said district between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN** that the aforesaid propositions will appear on the ballot used at such Annual District Meeting in the following form:

**PROPOSITION NO. 2**

**ELECTRIC VEHICLE INFRASTRUCTURE UPGRADE PROJECT**

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to wit:

RESOLVED, that (a) the Board of Education (the “Board”) of the Scotia-Glenville Central School District (the “District”) is hereby authorized to (A) construct improvements to and reconstruct buildings, facilities and sites at 500 Sacandaga Road (the Transportation Facility) in order to accommodate electric buses, the acquisition of which is mandated by New York State, at a maximum aggregate cost of not to exceed \$2,600,000, (B) expend such sum for such purpose, (C) levy the necessary tax therefore, to be levied and collected in annual installments in such years and in such amounts as may be determined by the Board in accordance with Section 416 of the Education Law taking into account state aid and other incentives and rebates, and (D) in anticipation of the collection of such tax, issue bonds and notes of the District at one time or from time to time in the principal amount not to exceed \$2,600,000 and levy a tax to pay the interest on said obligations when due?

**NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN** that an Environmental Assessment Form has been completed for the project, which is an unlisted action under the State Environmental Quality Review Act (“SEQRA”), a thorough review of the Project’s potential environmental impacts has been undertaken, it has been found that the Project will not result in a significant adverse impact on the environment, and a reasoned elaboration of the SEQRA review and findings has been provided in a Negative Declaration. The District Clerk or the Clerk’s designee is hereby directed to add the above-referenced provisions to the notice of the annual meeting of the District, working in consultation with the District’s counsel. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN**, that petitions nominating candidates for the office of member of the Board of Education to fill the following vacancies for a term of three years to fill the expiring terms of:

Must be filed with the Clerk of the District between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, no later than Monday, April 21, 2025. Each petition must be directed to the Clerk of the District, must be signed by at least 25 qualified voters of the district, must state the residence of each signer, and must state the name and residence of the candidate.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN**, that applications for early mail ballots will be obtainable during school business hours from the District Clerk beginning April 20, 2025; completed applications must be received by the District Clerk at least seven (7) days before the election if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or the day before the election, if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter. Early mail ballots must be received by the District Clerk no later than 5:00 p.m., prevailing time, on May 20, 2025.

A list of persons to whom early mail ballots are issued will be available for inspection to qualified voters of the District in the office of the District Clerk through May 19, 2025, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. on weekdays prior to the day set for the annual election and on May 20, 2025.

In order to vote at a school district election or meeting, a person must be at least eighteen years of age, a United States citizen and a resident of the school district for thirty days next preceding the election or meeting. The District will utilize the Voter Register of The Schenectady County Board of Elections as certified to the District by the County Board of Elections.

Applications for absentee ballots for election of Board Members and voting upon all propositions may be applied for at the office of the Clerk of the District. A list of all persons to whom absentee ballots shall have been issued will be available in the said office of the Clerk on each of the five days prior to the day of the election except Saturdays and Sundays.
